Tom Johnson (*1939) received B.A. and M.Mus. degrees from Yale and studied privately with Morton Feldman. Recent activities for his 80th birthday include the presentation of the new anthology *Finding Music* (in English and German, *Musik-Texte*), the sound installation with wood blocks in collaboration with Martin Riches, *Knock on Wood*, and special concerts in Amsterdam, San Sebastian, and Paris. A selection of his columns published in *The Village Voice* and a collection of radio programs, *Music by my Friends*, are available on his web site, and a number of video clips of his *Illustrated Music* can be seen on You Tube. His books include *Self-Similar Melodies* (Editions75), *Looking at Numbers* (with Franck Jedrzejewski, Springer Verlag), and *Other Harmony* (Editions 85).
